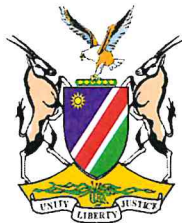

SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

The **Ministry of Mines and Energy** reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per site, or
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation or to cancel the quotation process; and
- (c) reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the services mentioned in Section III, by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration, where applicable;
- (b) the Priced Activity Schedule in Section IV;
- (c) the Specifications and Performance Standards in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment as deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Quotations document, including the Contract Data Sheet in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The quotation validity period shall be for **30 days** from the date of submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- a) have a **valid copy** of company Registration Certificate;
- b) have an **original/certified copy of valid** good Standing Tax Certificate; **(Certified by Namibia Police or Commissioner of oath)**
- c) have an **original/certified copy of valid** good Standing Social Security Certificate; **(Certified by Namibia Police or Commissioner of Oath)**
- d) have a **valid certified** copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42

of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998; **(Certified by Namibia Police or Commissioner of Oath)**

- e) Submit signed Bid-securing Declaration.
- f) Kindly initial all pages of this document where possible
- g) No correction fluid allowed
- h) Bidder's business Principal description should be in line with the requested goods/services.

5. Bid Security/Bid Securing Declaration

Bidders are required to **subscribe to a Bid Securing Declaration** for this procurement process.

6. Contract Period for Services

The contract shall be on fixed rate for a period of **30 days**. *If specified.*

7. Documents to be submitted

Bidders shall submit along with their quotation documents giving company's profile, and all relevant documents.

8. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number and addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name at the back of the envelope.

9. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Bid Box located at **6 Aviation Road, Ground Floor, Block F1; Office F1 005** not later than **24 February 2020 at 10h00**. Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach **6 Aviation Road** by the same date and time at latest. Late quotations will be rejected.

Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

10. Opening of Quotations

The Public Entity will open quotations internally at a time determined by the Public Entity after the closing time referred to in section 9 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the Bidders and the amount, the presence or absence of a Bid-Securing Declaration will be provided to any bidder on request within three (3) working days of the Opening.

11. Evaluation of Quotations

The **Ministry of Mines and Energy** shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of evaluated cost to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

12. Scope of Services and Performance Standards

The Scope of Services, Specifications and Performance standards detailed in Sections III and V are to be complied with.

13. Price and Currency of Payments

Quotations shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars and all payments will be made in this currency. Quotations shall cover all costs of labour, materials, equipment, overheads, profits and all associated costs for performing the services, and shall include all duties. The whole cost of performing the services shall be included in the items stated, and the cost of any incidental services shall be deemed to be included in the prices quoted.

14. Labour Clause

In order to qualify for award of the Contract, bidders shall subscribe to the undertaking that the salaries and wages to be paid in respect of this bid are compliant with the relevant Laws, Remuneration Order and Award where applicable and that it will abide to the sub-clause 4.6 of the General Conditions of Contract, if it is awarded the contract or part thereof.

THE APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER TO ASSIST SSMD WITH CONSTRUCTION/ ERECTION OF A FENCE AND SETTING UP OF A CORRUGATED IRON SHACK AT THE NOORDOEWER SLATE PROJECT

Place: Slate project site
Noordoewer settlement

1. SCOPE AND EXTENT OF WORK

We are looking for a contractor with experience in **erecting fences** and setting up (welding) **corrugated iron shacks** made with **square tubes**. The contractor will be responsible for doing everything required to complete the whole process, this includes: the procurement of materials, delivering of materials to the project site (Noordoewer), erection of the fence as well as the setting up of the tile's storage facility at Noordoewer, Karas region.

- The fence should be made with concrete at the base to firmly hold the ripper mesh to the ground. The fence concrete should be built with some water drainpipes (PVC 110 mm) to let water out of the yard when it rains. The poles spacing should be **three metres (3 m)** apart.
- The floor of the tile's storage facility should be made with concrete and covered up with slate off-cuts (freely available on site!!).

Bidder shall provide quote in strict accordance with all details contained in the bidding document.

2. DURATION OF THE PROJECT

The project must be completed within a maximum of two (2) months after the signing of the Service Level Agreement (SLA) by both parties.
