EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FOR THE REVIEW OF INDUSTRIAL POLICY FOR THE REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA AND ITS IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGY (SC/RP/15-15/25/26)

The Ministry of Industries, Mines and Energy (MIME), through the Directorate of Industrial Development (DID), hereby invites reputable consultants, research institutions, and/ or consulting companies to submit their Expression of Interest for the review and update of Namibia's Industrial Policy and Implementation strategy.

OBJECTIVE

The purpose of this assignment is to assess the current industrial policy framework, evaluate its effectiveness in promoting sustainable industrial growth, and recommend strategic updates aligned with Namibia's Vision 2030, National Development Plan 6 (NDP6) and emerging local, regional, continental and global economic trends.

SCOPE OF WORK

1. Review existing industrial policy and strategy documents.
2. Conduct stakeholder consultations with the government, private sector, and civil society.
3. Benchmark Namibia's industrial policy against regional and international best practices.
4. Provide recommendations for policy reforms and strategic interventions.
5. Draft a revised Industrial Policy and Implementation Strategy document.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Interested parties must demonstrate:

1. Proven expertise in industrial policy formulation and analysis, economic development, or related fields.
2. Experience in conducting national-level policy reviews or strategy development.
3. Strong knowledge of Namibia's economic landscape customs and regional integration frameworks (SACU, SADC, AU, AfCFTA) and green industrialisation.
4. Demonstrable experience in regional, continental and global economic contexts.
5. Strong qualitative and quantitative research skills.
6. A Master Degree from a recognised University in Economics,
7. Excellent English report-writing skills; ability to synthesise complex data.
8. For regional and international applicants, joint ventures with local Namibian entities are encouraged.
9. Capacity to deliver within agreed timelines.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

EOIs must include:

- A cover letter expressing interest
- Company/consultant profile and relevant experience
- Workplan with a detailed methodology
- Financial proposal/ with a breakdown of the budget
- CVs of key experts

TIME FRAME

The assignment is expected to be completed within a period of approximately four **(4) months** from the date of contract commencement. subject to the approval of the inception report and the agreed implementation schedule.
