Minimum Requirement: A Bachelor Degree in Economics/Electrical Engineering or Energy related qualification or any equivalent qualification (NQA Level 7), plus nine (9) years appropriate experience in Electricity/Energy sector or any related field of which 3 years must be at supervisory level.

- Experience in conducting electricity/energy research and energy data management.

Key Responsibilities:

- The applicant will be responsible for all planning and research related activities of the Energy directorate.
- Drive electricity sector policy development and implementation.
- Review and analysis of development programmers and projects of the Energy directorate and advise accordingly.
- Provide administrative, financial, and other related support services to the Energy directorate.
- Assist with the definition, planning and execution of rural electrification projects where needed.
- Assist with the attainment of the electrification targets as set out in NDP5 and Harambee Prosperity Plan.
- Devise the processes to enable the Directorate to compile a State of Energy Report.

- Assist in developing an electricity sector stakeholder engagement plan and stakeholder satisfaction survey tool; and others
- Data collection and information dissemination (including report writing).
- Benchmarking of energy statistics in the region and internationally to determine the types of statistics that should be produced, including an assessment of Namibia's needs for energy data and statistics for planning and other purposes.
- Determining the data required to reliably and accurately produce the chosen statistics.
- Assessing existing data sources, and developing a framework for improving and adding data sources that can support the required statistics and information, including identification of stakeholders who have or can collect such data.
- Assist with organizational planning.
- Overseeing the overall management and administration of the division planning and research.
