Roustabout:

Valid Rigging Certificate

Previous Rigging experience of not less than 2 years sea time working offshore on Tugs, supply vessels, mining vessels. Any prior experience working on offshore drilling rigs would be highly advantageous

Roughneck

Previous Offshore work experience of not less than 2 years sea time working on Tugs, supply vessels, mining vessels. Two years or more of role specific experience as a Roughneck working on Offshore or Land Drilling rigs, sound knowledge of best practices and processes, well familiar with drill floor and derrick working environment and activities.

Rig Admin/Radio Operator:
