### SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

### 1. Rights of Public Entity

The **Ministry of Mines and Energy** reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per lot; and
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation or to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

### 2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the works mentioned in Section III, by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration, where applicable;
- (b) the Priced Activity Schedule in Section IV;
- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment as deemed appropriate

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your Quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

### 3. Validity of Quotations

The quotation validity period shall be **30 days** from the date of bid submission deadline.

### 4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- have a valid certified company Registration Certificate; (certified by Namibian police)
- b) have an original valid good Standing Tax Certificate; (certified by Namibian police)
- c) have an original valid good Standing Social Security Certificate. (certified by Namibian police)
- have a valid certified copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998; (certified by Namibian police)
- e) Complete and sign attached Bid Securing declaration.

- f) Complete and sign an **undertaking on the part of the Bidder** that the salaries and wages payable to its personnel in respect of this proposal are compliant to the relevant laws, Remuneration Order, and Award, where applicable and that it will abide to sub-clause 4.6 of the General conditions of Contract if it is awarded the contract or part thereof; and;
- g) Submit the certificate of fitness for the company (Compulsory)
- h) Submit proof from a supplier in your company's name for the commitment to supply building materials and equipment to your company.
- i) All pages of the bidding documents should be initialled where possible.

### 5. Bid Security/Bid Securing Declaration

Bidders are required to submit a Bid Securing Declaration for this procurement process.

### 6. Works Completion Period

The completion period for works shall be **7 working days** after acceptance and issue of Purchase Order. Deviation in completion period shall not be accepted/shall be considered if such deviation is reasonable.

### 7. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the **Ministry of Mines and Energy** with the Bidder's name at the back of the envelope.

#### 8. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Bid Box located at 6 Aviation Road, Ground Floor, Block F1, Office F1 005 not later than **09 February 2024 at 10h00**. Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach 6 Aviation Road by the same date and time at latest. Late auotations will be rejected.

Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

### 9. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the Public Entity immediately after the closing time referred to in section 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, the presence or absence of a Bid Security/Bid Securing Declaration, will be posted on the website of the Public Entity and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

#### 10. Evaluation of Quotations

The Public Entity shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of evaluated cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest substantial evaluated quotation.

- > Selection of the successful bidder will not necessarily be based on the lowest submitted bid but on the lowest substantial responsive bid with the best long lasting technical proposal for the Carport shed repairs.
- Preference will be given to Companies operating in the Erongo region.
- > Bidders MUST give 2 years warrant period after the completion on work.

### 11. Technical Compliance

The Specifications and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the works to be carried out. The specifications have to be met, but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

### 12. Prices and Currency of Payment

Prices for the execution of works shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars as quoted.

Quotations shall cover all costs of labour, materials, equipment, overheads, profits and all associated costs for performing the works, and shall include all duties. The whole cost of performing the works shall be included in the items stated, and the cost of any incidental works shall be deemed to be included in the prices quoted.

IT COULD BE DUE TO THE WEIGHT OF SOLAR PANELS AND AN INDICATION FOR WEAKER WOOD PILLARS STARTS GIVING IN. THE TWO PILLARS JUST SPRUNG OFF FROM THE WOOD COLUMN CAUSING THAT MIDDLE PART TO BEND IN.

WE SOUGHT TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FROM THE SECTOR, TO AVOID FURTHER DAMAGES TO SOLAR PANELS. AGAIN, WE CONTACTED DEPARTMENT OF WORKS FOR EMERGENCY, A JOB CARD WAS ISSUED – NO ONE TURNED UP.

THIS IS AN EASY FIX, IF WE HAD TOOLS. ITS ABOUT PUTTING IT BACK TO ITS ORIGINAL LEVEL AND SECURE ALL PILLARS TO COLUMN WITH BOLTS, NOT NAILS OR GLUE AS IT IS THE CASE NOW.

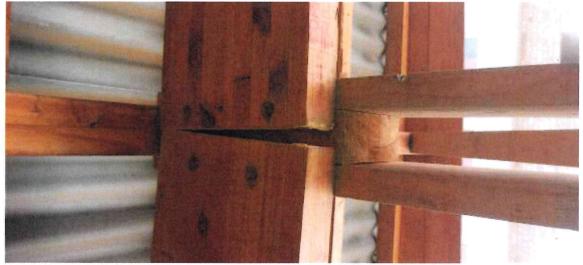
